And on the application of Counsel for the Petitioner it is ordered
that

the children, issue of the marriage between the Petitioner and Respondent, do
remain in the custody of the Petitioner until further order of the Court, but it is
directed that such children be not removed out of the jurisdiction of the Court
without its sanction.

And it is further ordered that the Petitioner do pay to the Respondent her
taxed costs, not to exceed the ~~amount ordered to be paid into Court or secured~~
for the Wife's costs of hearing.

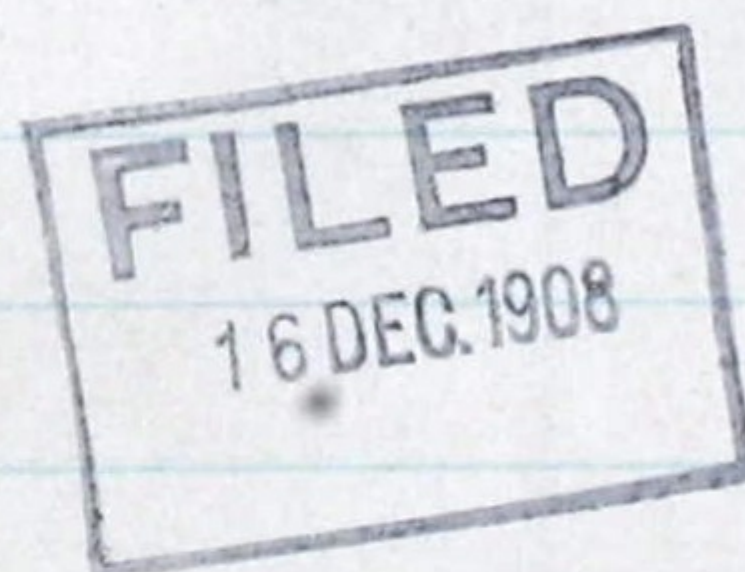

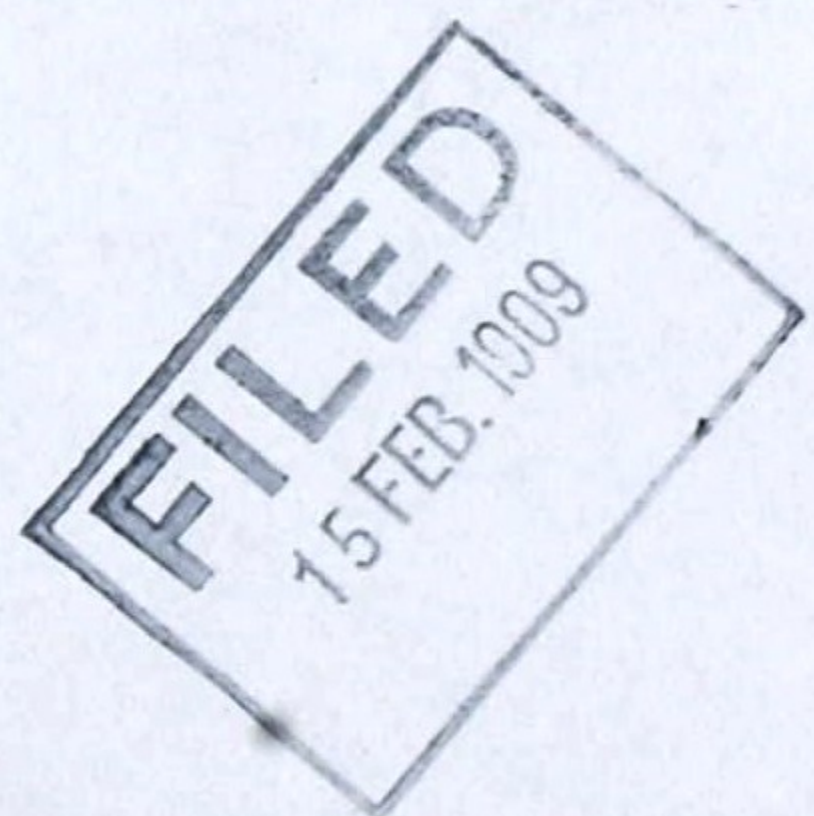

Sheweth as follows:

1. That on the 29th day of November 1887 at the Wesleyan Chapel Cleethorpes in the County of Lincoln your Petitioner was married to the Respondent Elizabeth Ridal then Elizabeth Pygott
2. That after the said marriage your Petitioner lived and co-habited with his said Wife at Hilda Street Great Grimsby in the County of Lincoln and at Grafton Street Great Grimsby in the County of Lincoln and other places and there is issue of the said marriage now living two children viz Joseph Ernest Ridal born on the 22nd day of January 1889 and Percy Ridal born on the 30th day of March 1891
3. Your Petitioner is a Stonemason and is now resident at Scartho road Great Grimsby in the County of Lincoln and at the time of the institution of these proceedings the domicile of your Petitioner is English and the residence of the said Elizabeth Ridal is at 7 Marshalls Tenace

off Blackbull Street -

Hunslet Road Leeds in the County of York.

4. That there have never been any previous proceedings in the Divorce Division of the High Court in reference to your Petitioners said marriage by or on behalf of your Petitioner or the said Elizabeth Ridal.

5. Differences having arisen between your Petitioner and the said Elizabeth Ridal your Petitioner and the said Elizabeth Ridal by deed dated the fourteenth day of April 1892 agreed to live separately and apart and have since the said fourteenth day of April 1892 lived separately and apart.

6. The said Elizabeth Ridal has committed adultery with a man or men whose name or names are unknown to your Petitioner.

7. On or about the 17th day of February 1896 at Carlton in the County of York the said Elizabeth Ridal was delivered of a female child of which your Petitioner was not the father. The said child was registered in the name of Eileen the mothers name was stated as Elizabeth Ridal formerly Pygott and the fathers name was stated to be Thomas Ernest Ridal.

8. On or about the 4th day of September 1897 at Wistow in the County of York the said Elizabeth Ridal was delivered of a female child of which your Petitioner was not the father. The child was registered in the name of Gladys Mary Hardy Reynold. The mothers name was stated as Elizabeth Ridal formerly Pygott and the fathers name was stated as Thomas Ernest Ridal.

Your Petitioner therefore prays that this Honourable Court will be pleased to decree

1. That your Petitioners said marriage with the said Elizabeth Ridal may be dissolved.
2. That your Petitioner may have such further and other relief as to this Honourable Court may seem meet.
