TOM HARRY HALFORD.

THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me Tom Harry Halford of The Ashlands, Blaby, in the County of Leicester Timber Merchant I appoint my friends William Scott of Welford Road Blaby aforesaid Plumber and Fred Atkins of Blaby aforesaid Schoolmaster (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will and I BEQUEATH to each of them the said William Scott and Fred Atkins the legacy or sum of Fifteen pounds (free of duty) as an acknowledgment of their kindness in accepting and acting in the execution of the trusts of this my Will I GIVE AND BEQUEATH the following pecuniary legacies namely:- To my dear wife Emily Halford the sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds to be paid to her as soon as possible after my decease To Mary Lee of Welford Road Blaby the sum of Two hundred pounds to be paid to her upon her attaining the age of twenty one years and to my granddaughter Shirley Lydia Halford the sum of One thousand pounds to be paid to her upon her attaining the age of twenty one years I GIVE AND BEQUEATH all my household furniture and such like effects unto my said wife Emily Halford for her own use and benefit absolutely I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all the rest residue and remainder of my real and personal estate whatsoever and wheresoever and of what nature or kind soever the same may be or consist unto my Trustees Upon trust to sell collect and convert the same into money and after payment thereof of my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses and the legacies hereinbefore bequeathed and the duties thereon I DIRECT my Trustees to stand possessed of the ultimate Residue thereof (hereinafter called "my Residuary Estate") Upon trust to invest the same upon investments authorised by law for the investment of trust funds and to pay the whole of the income to arise therefrom to my said wife Emily Halford for and during her life PROVIDED ALWAYS and I HEREBY DECLARE that if during any one or more years the net income of my residuary estate shall amount to less than Three hundred pounds per annum My Trustees shall from time to time raise and pay to my said wife such part or parts of the capital thereof as may be necessary to make up such income to Three hundred pounds per annum and further that the whole of the income from my residuary estate howsoever the same may be invested shall be paid to my said wife and no part thereof shall be deemed to form part of capital and upon the decease of my said wife I GIVE to my son Walter James Halford an annuity of Two hundred pounds per annum for his life payable by equal quarterly payments the first

whereof shall be made at the end of three months after the death of my said wife and I authorise my Trustees to provide for the payment of the said annuity by setting apart and appropriating in respect thereof such part or parts of my Residuary Estate as shall in their opinion be sufficient by the income thereof to pay such annuity AND I DECLARE that when such appropriation shall be made the said annuity shall be wholly charged on the investments so appropriated (hereinafter referred to as "the annuity fund") in exoneration of the remainder of my Residuary Estate but that the capital of the annuity fund may be resorted to in case at any time the income thereof is insufficient to pay such annuity and upon the death of my said son I DIRECT my Trustees to pay or transfer the annuity fund or such part thereof as shall then remain unto my daughter Elsie Elizabeth Halford for her own use and benefit absolutely to whom I GIVE AND BEQUEATH the same accordingly and after making provision for the said annuity in manner aforesaid I DIRECT my Trustees to pay or transfer the remainder of my Residuary Estate unto my said daughter Elsie Elizabeth Halford for her own use and benefit absolutely to whom I GIVE AND BEQUEATH the same accordingly AND LASTLY I hereby revoke all former Wills and testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last Will and Testament IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand this twenty eighth day of December One thousand nine hundred and thirty five.
